Our mission is to commemorate the pivotal role of air power in preserving freedom, by connecting generations to stories of heroism and aircraft that have shaped history.

We endeavor to be an enduring monument and education hub that honors ingenuity, courage, and sacrifice from the First World War to today.

Since opening in 1997, we have stood as a memorial to the 30,000 members of the US Army Air Forces who died while flying from Britain during World War II.

Over 850 objects including equipment, uniforms, keepsakes, and photographs, illustrate the individual experiences of 85 people from over 100 years of Anglo-American history. From Private to President these people's lives have shaped, or been shaped, by their experiences of war.

Our members play a pivotal role in the work that we do. They help us preserve our collections and sustain the museum. This ensures future generations can hear powerful stories about the people who made up over a century of Anglo-American history.
